Annalisa Mangiaracina is Full Professor of Criminal Procedure at the University of Palermo, Department of Law, where she teaches courses on Criminal Procedure Law, European, International and Comparative Criminal Procedure, Judicial cooperation, Security and migrant's rights. She coordinated for the University of Palermo a European Project (EUROCOORD) on the European Investigation Order and took part to several European research projects. Her research interests covers: proceedings in absentia; appeals; extraordinary remedies; instruments of judicial cooperation in criminal matters; EPPO; rights of migrants. She is author of two books - *Garanzie partecipative e giudizio in absentia* (Giappichelli, 2010) and *La conversione dell'impugnazione. Un istituto da ripensare* (Giappichelli, 2020) - and several articles and collective works on different topics regarding national criminal procedure law as well as European and International criminal procedure law, written also in English and Spanish. Currently she is working on AI and, specifically, on facial recognition.
