She also edited *Terrorismo e Mafia* (Viella, 2020) and *Non solo per amore* in memory of Francesca Morvillo (Treccani, 2022). She took part in numerous research projects of both national and international relevance; she organised and participated as a speaker in several conferences in Italy and abroad; she has been a Fellow researcher at the Institute of Advanced Legal Studies in London. She won a scholarship at the *Max-Planck-Institut zur Erforschung von Kriminalität, Sicherheit und Recht in Freiburg*.
